Pottawatomie County Junior Livestock Show Educational Scholarship Information

The Pottawatomie County Junior Livestock Show Committee along with the Shawnee Chamber of Commerce Ag Task Force Committee has set aside monies to fund scholarships annually for the Pottawatomie County Junior Livestock Show exhibitors. The amount of the scholarships will be (three) \$1500.00, one per specie, beef, sheep/goat, and swine.

In order to be eligible to apply for the scholarship money applicants must meet the following guidelines:

- 1. He/She must be a member in good standing in a Pottawatomie County 4-H or FFA group and be an exhibitor during the current Pottawatomie County Junior Livestock Show.**
- 2. Applicant must have a minimum of an over-all grade point average of 2.5.**
- 3. Applicant should be on track to graduate, a representative of good citizenship and be well-rounded.**
- 4. Applicant must show proof of enrollment and completed one semester of college level classes, career-tech or an accredited institution or school of agriculture related specialty training before receiving funds.**
- 5. Applicant must be a graduating senior.**

Applications will be submitted to a committee formed from the Pottawatomie County Junior Livestock Show committee for review. Winners will be announced the evening of the premium sale. The recipients will receive the scholarship money at the following year Pottawatomie County Junior Livestock show the evening of the premium sale.
